**Check you know how to use conditionals for hypothetical situations**

Talking about hypothetical situations, using 'if' sentences, use the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> conditional, depending on whether you think the situation is possible or not. We often mix the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> conditionals.

**2<sup>nd</sup> conditional:** if+past simple, would+infinitive (no 'to')

If it rained on the day of my party, I would feel really disappointed      The possible future

**3<sup>rd</sup> conditional:** if+past perfect, would have+past participle (verb 3)

If it had rained on the day of my party last year, it would have ruined the whole day  
The impossible!

If you were married with two small children, and you had a job with a good salary, but you were bored, would you give it up and take your family travelling round the world for a year?

**Check you know how to indicate uncertainty**

I don't know but,...      I'd like to think I'd...      I think I'd probably...      It depends...
